5MBS will record the 30 June concert and each YAS participant will receive a CD of the performance.

Students must be currently taking lessons with a teacher

- Participants must make themselves available for all sections
- Choice of work(s) studied will be made in conjunction with soloists, teacher and the Guild
- Each participant's program will be approximately 5 to 10 minutes duration
- Work must be prepared in advance of the 1st rehearsal and under the supervision of your piano teacher
- Assistance in preparation for the first rehearsal will be provided by the Guild if requested
- Punctuality at all stages is essential for the smooth running of the program
- Participants must be keen to work with other musicians, respond positively to instruction and be prepared to take part in discussions
- Following the final concert, participants are required to write a short report on their experiences in this program
